#### Recommendation

It is recommended that the Commission review the Fall 2023 Field Permits for Holy Family, American Youth Soccer Organization (AYSO), and International FC.

#### **Discussion/Analysis**

Holy Family is a regular user who utilizes the space for flag football and is requesting use of Orange Grove. AYSO a regular user who utilizes the space for soccer, and is requesting the use of Orange Grove, Arroyo South, and Arroyo North fields. International FC is a new applicant, requesting use of Arroyo North and South fields. Field maintenance schedule has not been approved yet, however the fields at Arroyo will be closed in August and September for maintenance.

Holy Family Proposed Usage: August 21, 2023-November 23, 2023 Monday through Thursday 3:30 p.m.-5:00 p.m.

AYSO Proposed Usage: September 1, 2023-February 28, 2024 Monday through Friday 4:00 p.m.-10:00 p.m. Saturday and Sunday 8:00 a.m.-8:00 p.m.

International FC Proposed Usage: September-November 2023 Tuesday through Thursday 7:30 p.m.-9:00 p.m.

Items to Consider:

- Approve permit for AYSO starting September 25, 2023. For use of Orange Grove Field, approve use starting at 5:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday to allow time for Holy Family to hold practices.
- Orange Grove Field not available on October 27, 2023 (City's Halloween Event)
- Orange Grove Field not available October 29, 2023 (Arroyo Fest)
- Orange Grove Field not available November 27, 2023-January 31, 2024 (Field Maintenance)

Note: Registration for Arroyo Fest will take place at Orange Grove on October 28, 2023, from 10:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m. at the basketball court. Parking around the park will be limited due to this event.

#### **Next Steps**

- 2. Provide Holy Family its Fall 2023 Field Permit.

#### Background

In order to streamline the approval process, the Community Services Commission reviews the field permit allocation.

#### **Fiscal Impact**

The fiscal impact would be funds allocated for field maintenance through a contract. Staff is requesting a fee waiver for AYSO and Holy Family.

The greatest sorrow in life comes from losing someone you love. We hope you have found, and continue to find, much compassion in those around you as you express and experience your grief and loss.

We also hope that the garden can be a resource to you to help ease the pain a little and that you and all its visitors will have some moments of serenity and joy amidst your sorrow. Young and old are welcome to visit the garden anytime, to celebrate and remember the ones they have lost, reflect on their own life, or simply surround themselves with beauty and love.

The names in the garden are of the children of South Pasadena residents who have left us too soon (21 years and under at the time of death). By having their names engraved in the garden, we honor and remember their lives, and ensure that they will always remain a visible part of our community.

This form is the first step to adding a child's name to the garden. The information collected will be used to present the request to the Parks and Recreation Commission, and will otherwise remain confidential. Regular Commission Meetings are held the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday of each month with the exception of holidays.
