Background

The Community Services Department hosts four Concerts in the Park, three Movies in the Park, and two Shakespeare in the Park throughout the months of June, July, and August. These events provide a variety of music, family friendly movies, and fun brought to our community.

Analysis

2023 Summer Special Events Schedule & Attendance

Concerts in the Park are held on alternating Sundays to allow for different events on intermediary weeks, effectively creating a summer series of events for the community. This season concerts ran from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Sundays. Movies in the Park were hosted on the second Friday of each month and began at sunset. Below is the event schedule and attendance.
