1024 INDIANA AVENUE, SOUTH PASADENA, CA 91030**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of South Pasadena Cultural Heritage Commission will hold a Public Hearing on **Thursday, May 21, 2020, at 6:30 p.m. remotely by video conference** to consider a **Certificate of Appropriateness** for 1024 Indiana Avenue, (Project No. 2233-COA). Project site is approximately 0.14 acres, Assessor's Parcel Number 5313-013-014. Applicant's representative is Susana Juarez of NS Designs. The project consists of the following application:

- **Certificate of Appropriateness** for the addition of 1,090 square feet to the rear of an existing single-family home, demolition of a 279 square foot unpermitted rumpus room, demolition of a 75 square foot garage storage, and construction of a new 400 square foot detached carport.

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the project qualifies for a Categorical Exemption under Section 15301, Class 1 Existing Facilities and Section 15331, Class 31 Historical Resource Restoration/Rehabilitation. Class 1 exemption includes additions to existing structures provided that the addition will not result in an increase of more than 10,000 square feet in which the project site is in an area where all public facilities are available and is not located in an environmentally sensitive area. Class 31 exemption includes projects limited to maintenance, repair, stabilizations, rehabilitation, restoration, preservation, conservation or reconstruction of historical resources in a manner consistent with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties with Guidelines for Preserving, Rehabilitating, Restoring, and Reconstructing Historic Buildings (1995), Weeks and Grimmer.

This meeting is being conducted in compliance with Governor Newsom's Executive Order N-29-20 issued on March 17, 2020 to protect the health and safety of the public and to minimize the spread of the COVID-19 virus. The meeting will be broadcast live on the local cable channel and on the City's website, and a recording of the meeting will be available within 48 hours of the meeting adjournment at the following links:
