NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of South Pasadena Cultural Heritage Commission will hold a Public Hearing on <u>Monday, February 7, 2022, at 6:30 p.m. remotely by video conference</u> to consider a request for a Certificate of Appropriateness (Project No. 2445-COA) for a proposed 380-square-foot addition to an existing two-story, 2,220-square-foot single-family residence located at 1806 Wayne Avenue (APN: 5321-011-002). The project applicant is architect Bruce Ruggles.

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the project qualifies for a Categorical Exemption under Section 15301, Class 1 Existing Facilities and Section 15331, Class 31 Historical Resource Restoration/Rehabilitation. A Class 1 exemption includes additions to existing structures provided that the addition will not result in an increase of more than 10,000 square feet and not located in an environmentally sensitive area. A Class 31 exemption includes projects limited to maintenance, repair, stabilizations, rehabilitation, restoration, preservation, conservation or reconstruction of historical resources in a manner consistent with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic

Properties with Guidelines for Preserving, Rehabilitating, Restoring, and Reconstructing
