| am asking our committee to administer and acquire proper safety along the boulevard of Columbia St & Pasadena Ave.

On the morning of February 2nd at 4:55 am, a truck at high speed driving on Pasadena Ave towards Columbia St crashed through the bollards in front of this historical home, demolishing the topiary

on the boulevard (landscaped and paid for by the home owner) . This boulevard is the both a physical and visual entrance to the city of South Pasadena.

The Historical property at 1127 has lost several 16 - 20' tress, yard lighting, slate pavers, plants. and compromised the porch overhang.

The truck halted 10 feet away from wall under the bedroom.

Had this truck continued, the health and well being of the residents would have been in question.

It is time for the City of South Pasadena, Pasadena & Cal Trans to employ a safety audit team to redesign and engineer


the T intersection, implement a safety factor at the boulevard, and take a responsible measure to slow the cars driving on Pasadena Avenue towardsColumbia st.
