2. Draft Preservation Ordinance Revisions, Definitions Section

Since 1992, South Pasadena's preservation ordinance has been an effective tool for implementing the City's preservation efforts. However, the ordinance is deficient in certain places and does not address current preservation issues. In 2008, the City hired a historic preservation consultant to review the current ordinance for possible legal issues, antiquated content, and inconsistent language. The consultant prepared a complete revision to the ordinance that supports the City's Historic Preservation Element of the General Plan and the issues discovered in the review.

For the past 6 years, the Cultural Heritage Commission held several special meetings to focus on the consultant's draft ordinance in order to fine tune it so that the ordinance better achieves the City's preservation goals.

Discuss and
Edit the Draft Ordinance

Tonight, the Cultural Heritage Commission will hold a special meeting in order to focus on the last section of the draft preservation ordinance, which is the "definitions" section. Certain terms need refinement and other terms need to be defined. A concise set of definitions helps to clearly establish the scope of regulation, particularly the type of structures and other features subject to designation and review and the specific actions that trigger review.

The entire revised ordinance will be presented to the Cultural Heritage Commission at a future meeting, and the CHC will ultimately make a recommendation to the City Council.


