NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of South Pasadena Cultural Heritage Commission will hold a public hearing on <u>January 19, 2023, at 6:30 p.m.</u> through an in-person/<u>virtual hybrid meeting</u> to consider the following projects:

PROJECT NO. 2443-COA-AUP — A request for a Certificate of Appropriateness to add a 732-square-foot first-story addition, a 379-square-foot second-story addition, to demolish a 216-square-foot one-car garage, to construct a new 406-square-foot two-car garage at 504 El Centro Street (APN: 5313-008-003). In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the project qualifies for a Categorical Exemption under Section 15301, Class 1 (Existing Facilities) and Section 15331, Class 31 (Historical Resource Restoration/Rehabilitation).

PROJECT NO. 2481-COA — A request for a Certificate of Appropriateness to add a 705 two-story square-foot addition to the rear of an existing 1,902 square-foot two-story single-family residence for a property located at 1716 Wayne Avenue (APN: 5321-010-003). In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the project qualifies for a Categorical Exemption under Section 15301, Class 1 (Existing Facilities) and Section 15331, Class 31 (Historical Resource Restoration/Rehabilitation).

PROJECT NO. 2524-LHD — To review and make a recommendation to the City Council for a request for a Landmark Historic Designation for a single-family residence located at 534 Arroyo Drive (APN: 5317-042-017). The City Council is the reviewing authority that makes the final determination for the requested Landmark Historic Designation. In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the project qualifies for a Categorical Exemption under Section 15308, Class 8 – Actions taken by regulatory agencies, as authorized by state or local ordinance, to assure the maintenance, restoration, enhancement, or protection of the environment where the regulatory process involves procedures for protection of the environment.
