NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of South Pasadena Design Review Board will hold a Public Hearing on <u>Thursday</u>, <u>April 6</u>, <u>2023 at 6:30 p.m. through an in-person meeting</u> to consider the following project:

PROJECT NO. 2544-DRX — A request for a Design Review Permit for a new 505-square-foot second floor addition to an existing one-story, 2,126-square-foot single-family residence at 915 Adelaine Avenue (Assessor's Parcel Number: 5313-007-036). In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), this project qualifies for a Categorical Exemption under Section 15301, Class 1 (Existing Facilities).
