She then moved on to share an update on the new agreement with Athens Services. Per City Council direction, residents will be receiving new barrels for waste disposal and continuing backyard service. Lastly, she shared that the City of South Pasadena is continuing edible food recovery efforts through a partnership with San Gabriel Valley Council of Governments (COG).

Public Works Director, Ted Gerber, shared that the City is considering hosting a 626 Golden Streets event with local cities and San Gabriel Valley COG.
