NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of South Pasadena Planning Commission will hold a Public Hearing on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>May 11</u>, <u>2021</u>, <u>at 6:30 p.m. remotely by video conference</u> to consider a <u>Hillside Development</u> Permit, <u>Design Review</u>, <u>Tree Removal Permit</u>, <u>and two Variances (Project No. 2319-HDP/DRX/VAR)</u> to construct a multi-level single family home and attached accessory dwelling unit at 1502 Indiana Avenue, Assessor's Parcel Number 5314-006-020. Applicant is Kirk Nakagawa. The project consists of the following applications:

- 1. **Hillside Development Permit** to allow construction of a 2,478 square-foot multi-level single-family residence with an attached accessory dwelling unit on a site with an average slope of 20% or greater; and
- 2. Design Review for the proposed project; and
- 3. Tree Removal Permit to remove ten (10) trees on the site; and
- 4. **Two Variances** to deviate from the development standards to allow the project to provide 61.5% of the lot size to remain in its natural state instead of 63% as required by Section 36.340.050 (F) of the Hillside Protection Ordinance; and to allow a stair case within the side setback that exceeds 36 inches in height and 36 inches in width as provided in Section 36.300.030 (D) of the Zoning Code.

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the project qualifies for a Categorical Exemption under Section 15303, Class 3, Construction of Small Structures and Section 15332, Class 32, Infill Development. Class 3 exemption includes construction of one single-family residence. The project qualifies for a these exemptions because the project is for construction of a single-family home and is consistent with the general plan and zoning, occurs within city limits on a project site of no more than 5 acres that is substantially surrounded by urban uses, the site has no value as habitat for endangered, rare, or threatened species, the project would not result in any significant effects relating to traffic, noise, air quality, or water quality, and the site can be adequately served by all required utilities and public services.
