PLEASE NOTE: The City has discretion to adjust public comment time limit to less than three minutes, as needed.

Pursuant to State law, the advisory bodies may not discuss or take action on issues not on the meeting agenda, except that members of the advisory bodies or staff may briefly respond to statements made or questions posed by persons exercising public testimony rights (Government Code Section 54954.2). Staff may be asked to follow up on such items.
