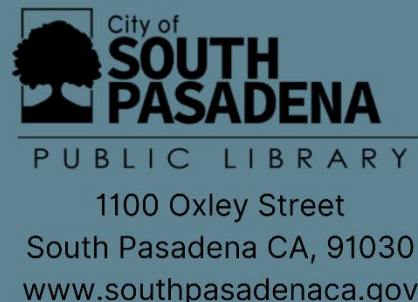

South Pasadena Public Library In-N-Out Cover to Cover Program, Teen Advisory Board (TAB) Crafternoons, and Fall Arts Crawl

South Pasadena (Calif.) – The South Pasadena Public Library is partnering with In-N-Out for the Cover to Cover Program. This program runs from Saturday, October 5 to Saturday, November 16. Children who read five books or 300 minutes will receive an Achievement Award Card, which is valid for a free hamburger or cheeseburger at any In-N-Out location. Child must be present with a parent or guardian at time of redemption.

Teen Advisory Board (TAB) will host Crafternoons, a free program that will take place on various days between Wednesday, October 16 and Saturday, November 16.
