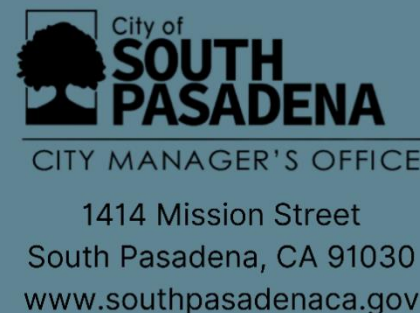

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Upcoming Construction at City Hall Parking Lots

South Pasadena (Calif.) – The City of South Pasadena is excited to inform the community on an upcoming project that will contribute to our community's sustainability efforts. Many of our community members have heard of or already seen our new electric police fleet, and the City is proud to share that this 'electrification project' includes the installation of charging infrastructure at City Hall.

Construction for this infrastructure project is in partnership with Southern California Edison (SCE), who will commence construction on Monday, April 15, 2024 and conclude by the end of June 2024. The infrastructure will not only serve the police fleet, but will also provide public-facing charging capability to the public after-hours.

Throughout the construction and installation phase, City staff and SCE will work together to further minimize disruptions to our residential and the surrounding business community. While occasional impacts on staff parking are inevitable, we are committed to containing our footprint to our lots as much as possible. To further minimize impacts, SCE will be conducting this construction in phases beginning with the Police Department parking lot, then into the Fire Department, concluding their work with the City Hall parking lot.
