Police Department Conducts Bicycle, Pedestrian Safety Operation

South Pasadena (Calif.) - On Friday, May 17, 2024, the South Pasadena Police Department carried out a bicycle and pedestrian safety operation in observance of the state's Bike Safety Month. This operation took place on Fremont Avenue, between Oak Street and Monterey Road, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. During this period, thirty-two individuals were contacted.

"Safety is a shared responsibility, with drivers holding the greatest responsibility to keep other road users safe," Chief Brian Solinsky said. "We hope this operation serves as a reminder to everyone to practice due care and to look out for one another."

The Police Department plans to conduct another safety operation in September 2024, aligning with the state's Pedestrian Safety Month.
