Announcing New English Language Conversation Group Evening Sessions at the South Pasadena Public Library

South Pasadena (Calif.) – Beginning April 4, 2023, the South Pasadena Public Library Conversational English Group will offer new Tuesday evening sessions from 6:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. in addition to the Wednesday sessions from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. in the Ray Bradbury Conference Room, on the second floor of the Library. The group is open to all adult English language learners who want to practice their spoken English. No advance registration is required — participants are welcome to walk in. Both groups are led by highly qualified native English speakers. Masks are required.


