Reference Desk beginning May 12, 2023 at 10:00 a.m.



TAB members came up with the idea and assembled the kits during their last meeting of the spring semester as a way to help their fellow teens through AP testing and finals week. The kits funded by the Friends of the South Pasadena Public Library are available on a first-come first-served basis while supplies last.
