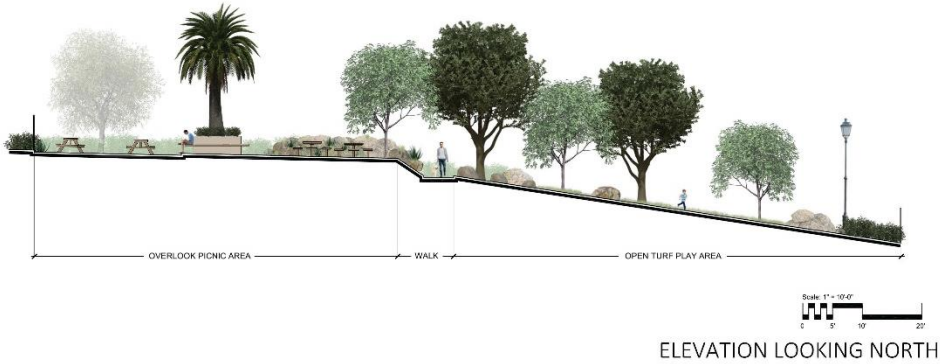

BERKSHIRE AVENUE PARK – Final Concept Plan (2018)



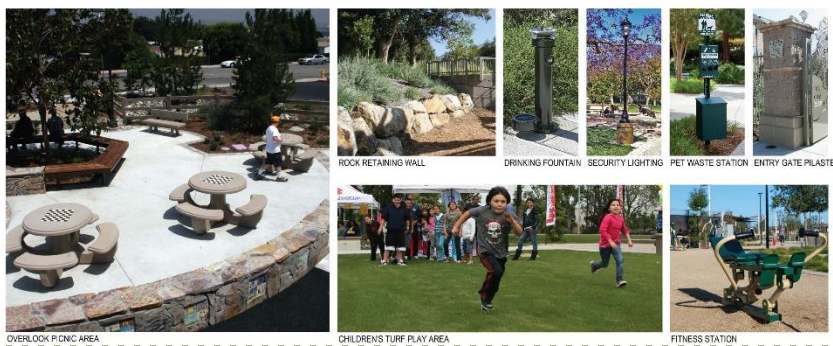

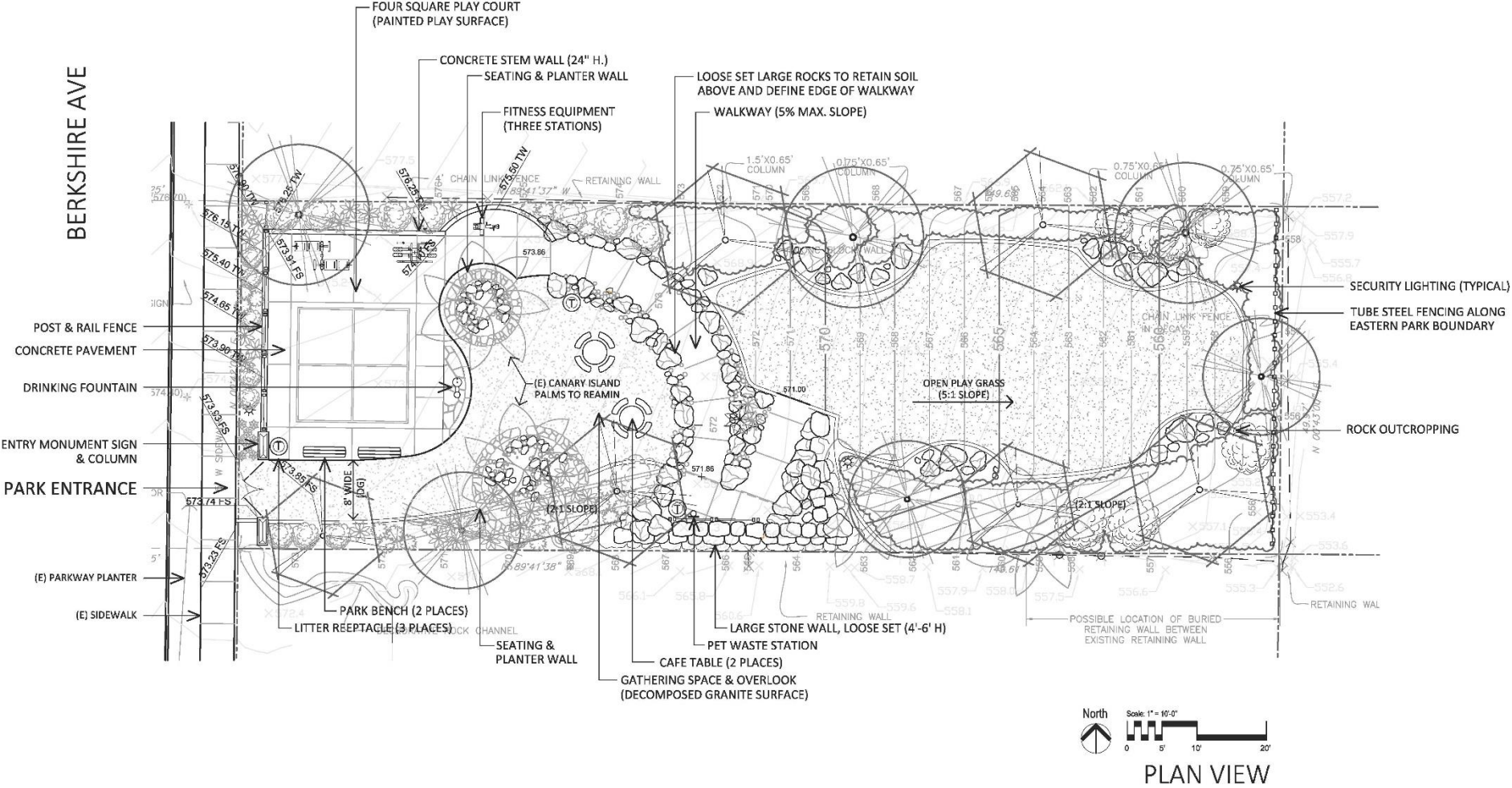

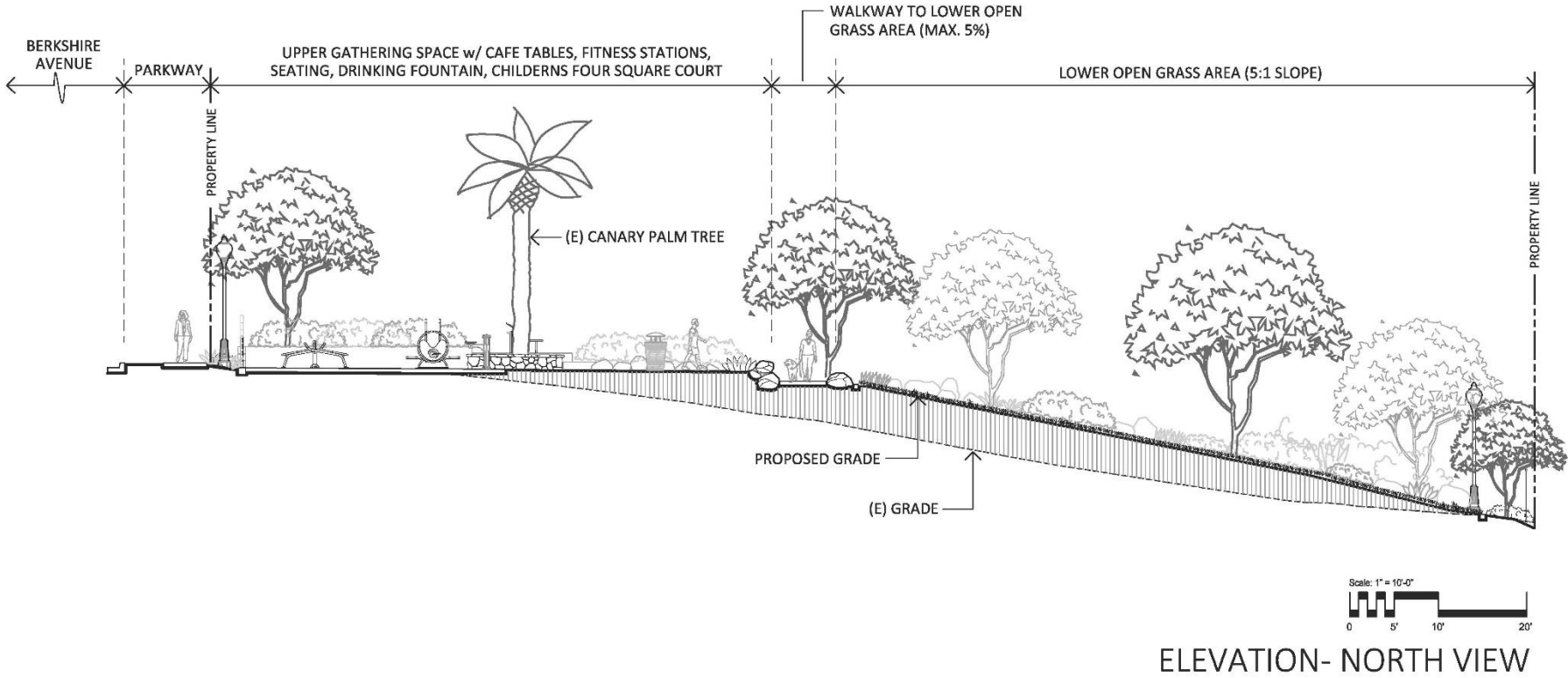


BERKSHIRE AVENUE PARK – Concept (2021)



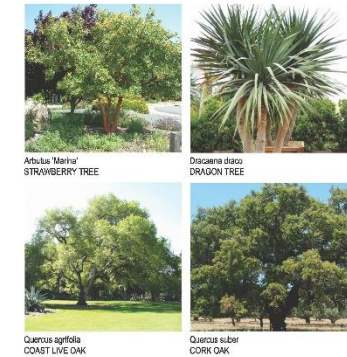

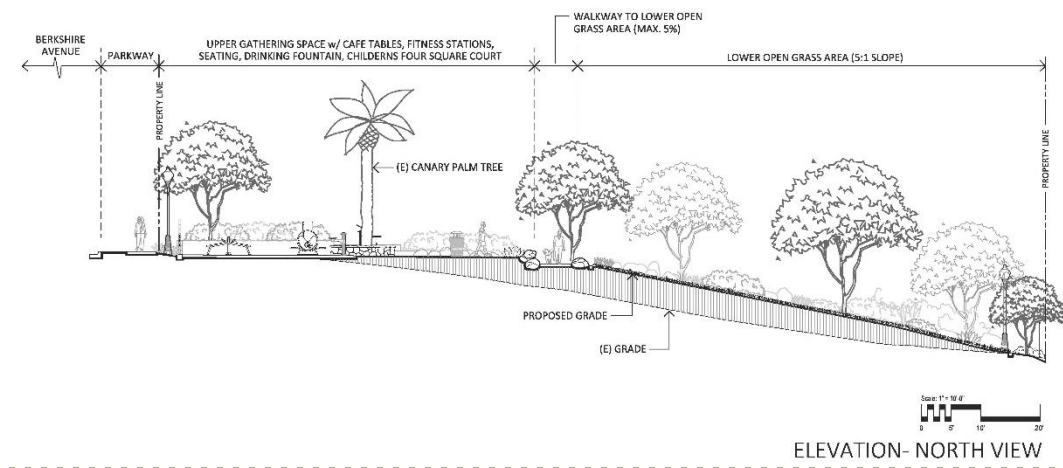
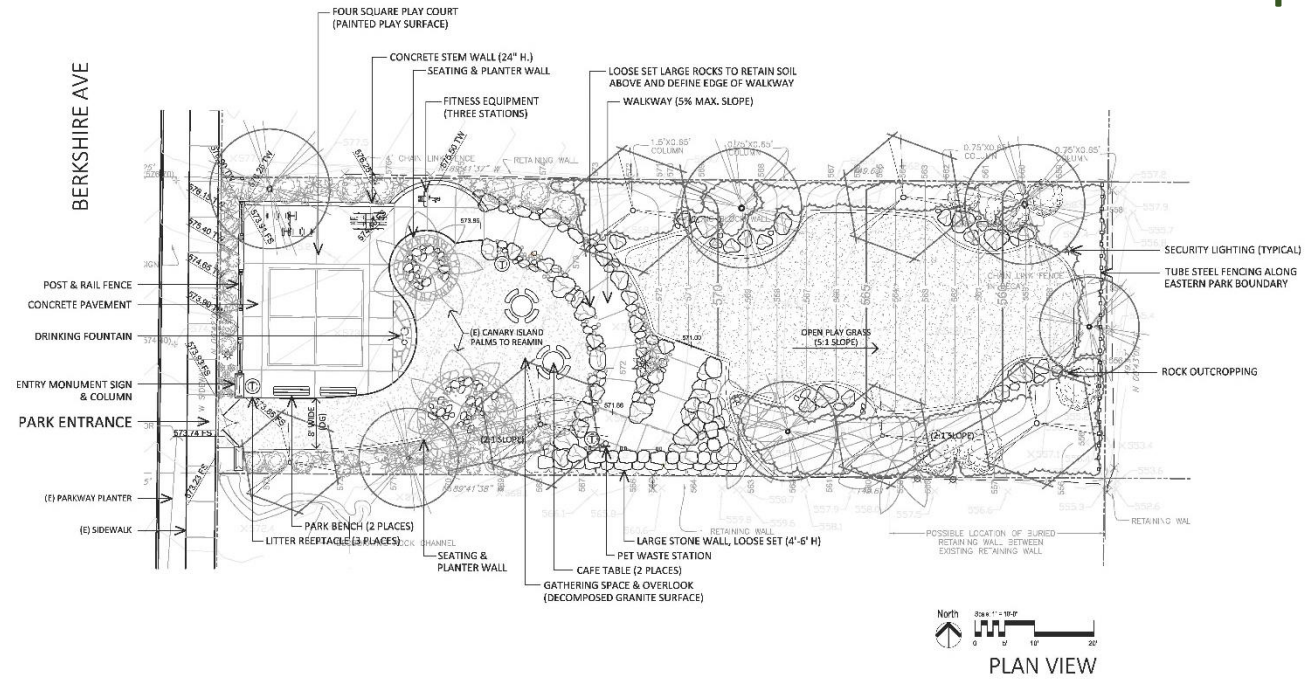
